- LG Electronics and Fujitsu have announced that they are OpenChain 2.0 conformant
- LG Electronics is being involved for a very ling time, they build out our Korean activities. Just today we had our fourth meeting of the Korean work group at Korean Telecom. They also locked down the schedule for 2020.
